

BEGINNING at a heap of stones at land of the Heirs of Timtha Alexander, Jr., it being the northwest corner of said two (2) acres and forty five (45) rods;

THENCE S. 1° S. fourteen and six tenths (14.6) rods to a heap of stones to land now or formerly of Thurber Warfield;

THENCE S. 5° E. twenty three and two tenths (23.2) rods to a heap of stones to land now or formerly of Elijah Thayer;

THENCE W. 10° S. fifteen and seven tenths (15.7) rods to a heap of stones at land now or formerly of Rufus Darling;

NORTHERLY by land of Willis Southwick and Heirs of Abel Aldrich and,



WESTERLY by land formerly of Verville Taft, or however otherwise bounded.
