THENCE- southwesterly along the northwesterly line of Blackstone Street to the northeasterly line of Emerson Street;

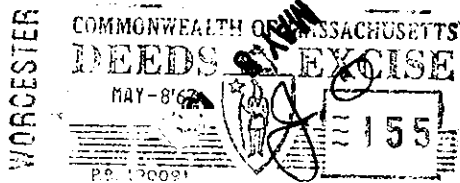
THENCE- northwesterly along the northeasterly line of Emerson Street to a stone wall at other land of these grantors;
