of twenty five dollars paid by John Burley of Men-
don in the County of Worcester and Commonwealth of
Massachusetts, yeoman, the receipt whereof is here-
by acknowledged do hereby give grant bargin,
sell and convey unto the said John Burley his heirs
and assigns a certain tract of land situated in
said Mendon on the Northwesterly side of the road
leading from the house of said Davenport to the
house of Early Taft in Upton and opposite the house
of Thomas Carey and bounded as follows, namely,
beginning at a point on said road at the South-
westerly corner of the premises or land improved
by said Davenport thence running Northwesterly
and bounded Northeasterly by land improved by
said Davenport thence running Northeasterly and
bounded Northwesterly by land improved by said
Davenport as the wall now stands to a corner
thence turning and running Southwesterly and boun-
ded Northwesterly by land improved by said Dav-
enport as the wall now stands to the road afore-
said, thence by and with the said road to the
first mentioned bound at the place of beginning.

To have and to hold the above granted
premises with all the privileges and appurtenances
thereto belonging to the said John Burley his heirs
and assigns to his & their use and behoof forever.
And I the said Charles A. Davenport for myself and
my heirs executors and administrators do covenant
with the said John Burley his heirs and assigns
that I am lawfully seized in fee simple of the afore-
granted premises, that they are free from all in-
curseances, that I have good right to sell and
convey the same to the said John Burley his heirs
and assigns forever as aforesaid and that I will
