Now therefore, in consideration of the said sum of One Hundred and Nine Dollars to me paid by the said Dennis Kelly, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, I do, as Guardian as aforesaid, and by virtue of the aforesaid license, hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Dennis Kelly, two certain tracts or parcels of land belonging to said Dennis Fallon, to wit: the second parcel described in said license containing 7 acres, more or less, of meadow and upland, on the Northwesterly side of the Old Turnpike, so called, bounded Northwesterly and Easterly by land now or formerly of John Cross and said Ward's other land, Southerly by said Turnpike, and Westerly by land of C. George Daniels and others. Being the premises conveyed to said ward by deed of Alanson Taft and Elizabeth W. Taft, dated December 4, 1872, and recorded with Worcester District Deeds Libro 899, Folio 34. Also the third parcel described in said license containing  $\frac{3}{4}$  of an acre, more or less, of meadow land, bounded Northwesterly by land of L. Edgar Wheeler, Easterly by land of Stephen Cook, Southerly by land of Elma M. Pond and others, and Westerly by said ward's other land above described, it being the premises conveyed to said ward by deed of Henry W.
