

41 links to a corner wall & bounded on said Grantors land & land of Warren Rawson thence N. 41 1/2° W. 26 rods & 22 links to a corner of a wall bounded on said Rawson's land thence N. 28° S. 15 rods & 10 links to a corner of a wall thence N. 41 1/2° W. 29 rods & 2/3 of a rod to a corner of a wall bounded on the grantors land thence S. 39° W. 52 1/2 rods to the corner of Seth Hastings land & bounded on his the said Hastings land thence E. 110° S. 29 rods to a stake & stones & bounded on George Taft's land thence S. 38° W. 10 rods & 2 links to stake & stones thence S. 30 1/2° E. 41 1/4 rods to the first mentioned bound & bounded on Elijah Taft's land it being the same piece of land that Eras Taft conveyed to me by deed April 14, 1808 & recorded in the same Registry of Deeds Book 170 Page 18 —

Also one other piece of land consisting of pasture & wood land lying on the North side of the turnpike road containing by estimation about thirty acres & one hundred & twenty two rods be the same more or less bounded as follows to wit, beginning at the Southeast corner adjoining said turnpike road thence E. 42° N. bounding on Samuel Gaskill's land about 6 rods to a heap of stones on the four rod road so called thence S. 21 1/2° rods or thereabouts about a various line bounding on said four rod road to the Southeast corner formed by said four rod road & said turnpike thence about 12 1/4 rods bounding on said turnpike to the first mentioned bounds —

Also one other piece of land lying on the South side of the turnpike above mentioned containing by estimation fourteen acres & thirteen rods be the same more or less bounded as follows to wit, beginning at the Northwest corner adjoining said turnpike road thence S. 5° E. about 74 1/2 rods to a large oak stump bounding on Samuel Gaskill's meadow land thence a straight line 37 1/4 rods to a stake & stone in the woods bounding southerly on land of Amariah Taft being the Southeast corner thence a straight line N. 11° W. about 54 rods to said turnpike road & bounding East on the grantors other land thence a various line bounding on said turnpike road about 36 1/4 rods to the first mentioned bounds. These two last mentioned pieces of land being the same that Anson Dexter conveyed to me by deed <sup>dated</sup> November 3, 1813 recorded in the same Registry Book 189 Page 205 —

Also one other piece of land containing thirty three acres & one hundred & fifty one rods being wood land & bounded as follows to wit, beginning at an oak tree by the turnpike road leading said Mendon from Hartford to Boston being the East corner of said piece & also the corner of land formerly belonging to John Penniman but supposed now to belong to Tyler Daniels thence S. 5° W. 31 1/2 rods to stakes by ash sprout & bounded Easterly on land that said Penniman once owned or that said Daniels now owns thence N. 11° S. 7 rods & 17 links to stake & stones bounded by land that formerly belonged to Peter Penniman thence N. 11° W. 106 rods to a stake & stones at said turnpike road & bounded Westerly on land that formerly belonged to M<sup>rs</sup> Sarah Jackson but now to Amariah Taft son land of the grantor thence Easterly as the said turnpike road runs to the first mentioned bounds & bounding on said turnpike road it being the same wood land that Anson Dexter conveyed to me by deed dated the 20<sup>th</sup> day of April 1814 & recorded in said Registry of Deeds Book 193 Page 34 —

Also one other piece of land bounded as follows to wit, beginning at a heap of stones near Muddy Brook at the new road leading from Mendon to Milford thence running S. 41° E. 32 1/2 rods then S. 43° W. 2 1/3 rods both of said lines bound on the Anson's farm so called thence S. 9° E. 36 1/2 rods to Richard George's land & bounding on M<sup>rs</sup> Davenport's land thence N. 58° E. 60 rods to land formerly belonging to George Aldrich but now to Amariah Taft & bounding on said Richard George's land thence N. 15° W. 36 rods to a heap of stones then N. 58° E. 7 rods then N. 58° E. 15 1/2 rods to a road leading by the house where said George Aldrich once lived then Northerly with said road about 49 rods to the first men =
