Hastings, which was then and has since been held and occupied as her dower legally assigned out of her deceased husband's estate, by Anna W. Hastings of said Mendon my said husband's mother. The same comprises three several tracts of land in and near Mendon Village viz: The lot on which stand what is known as the "Corner House" and a house occupied by L. Warren Cook, the "Calvin Barber Place" so called occupied by J. H. Ammabell and the Post Lane Pasture containing about 2.5 acres.
