SOUTHERLY by Miscoe Road, 153.22 feet;

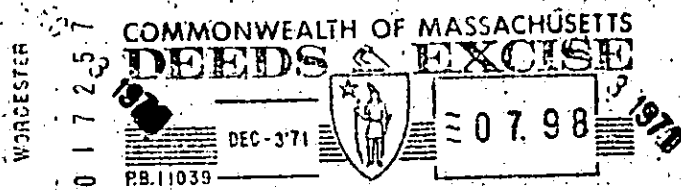
WESTERLY by land now or formerly of one Curley and other land of the grantor, 254.00 feet;
